

2017-2018 Team Ontario Selection

Team Ontario

Team Ontario provides enhanced training, development, and competitive opportunities for top junior players from Ontario. Team Ontario activities bring the selected players together for a series of camps, testing, and Team Ontario competitive opportunities that enhance what is already available through their personal and community golf programs. Team Ontario will be led by Head Coach Reggie Millage, and enhanced by a sport science team for the 2017-2018 season.

Eligibility

In order to be considered for selection for Team Ontario athletes must:

- Be a member in good standing with Golf Ontario
- Not be subject to any disciplinary process or sanctions by Golf Ontario
- Have unquestioned status as an amateur golfer
- Adhere to the Golf Ontario Code of Conduct
- Be a permanent resident of Ontario - residency is defined as having a primary residence in Ontario and having a valid OHIP card*
- Be a Canadian citizen and hold a Canadian passport
- Be under 19 years of age as of August 1, 2018

*Exemptions will be considered for those choosing to train in a warm climate area, while attending school.

Objective Selection Criteria

The selection of athletes to Team Ontario will be based on the following objective criteria:

- Scoring average from 2017 competition results
- Scoring differential from 2017 competition results
- Head to head results from 2017 competition rounds
- 2017 Golf Ontario Junior Order of Merit ranking
- 2017 Golf Ontario Juvenile Order of Merit ranking
- 2017 Golf Ontario Bantam Order of Merit ranking
- 2017 Golf Ontario Amateur Order of Merit ranking
- 2017 Golf Canada Junior Order of Merit
- 2017 Golf Canada Amateur Order of Merit
- 2017 Trackman and Flight Scope data
- 2017 National Testing Protocol Data

Subjective Selection Criteria

The selection of athletes to Team Ontario will be based on the following subjective criteria:

- Work ethic, behaviour (on and off course), and team compatibility
- Golf Ontario tracking and monitoring evaluations
- Performance trends
- Projected ability and athlete desire to achieve high performance benchmarks
- Athletes coachability

Selection Committee

The selection committee shall be comprised of the Golf Ontario Head Provincial Coach and two members of the NextGen Selection Committee who are all voting members. The Golf Ontario Play and Compete Coordinator will be a non-voting member and Chair of the committee to ensure that due process is followed.
