


## Golf Canada Mobile App Hole-by-Hole Score Entry

**\*Download the Golf Canada App\***


**Step 1: Sign in using your Golf Canada username and password**

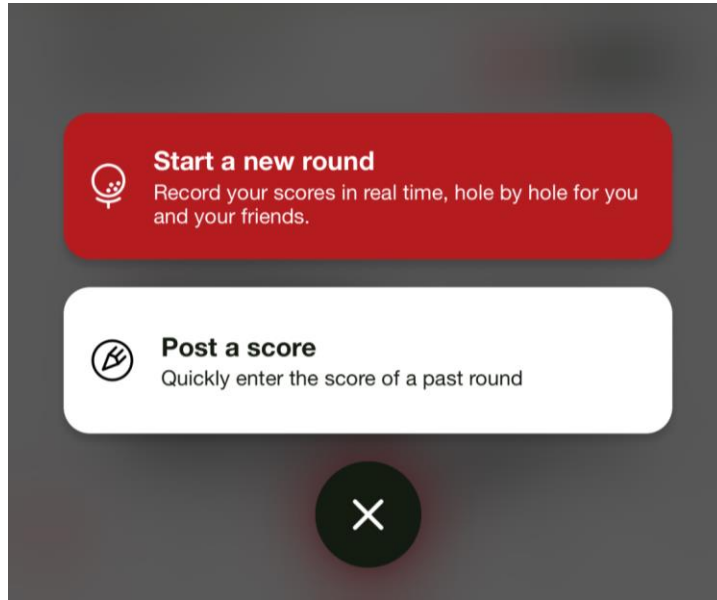




